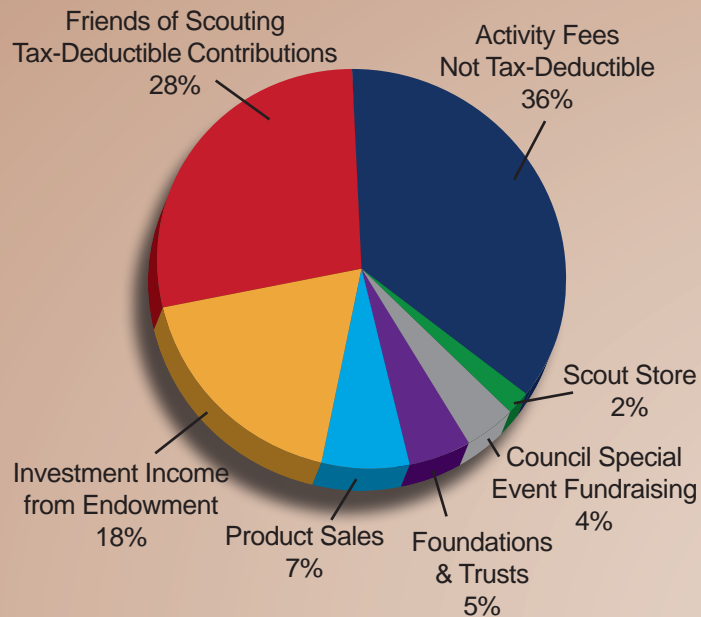
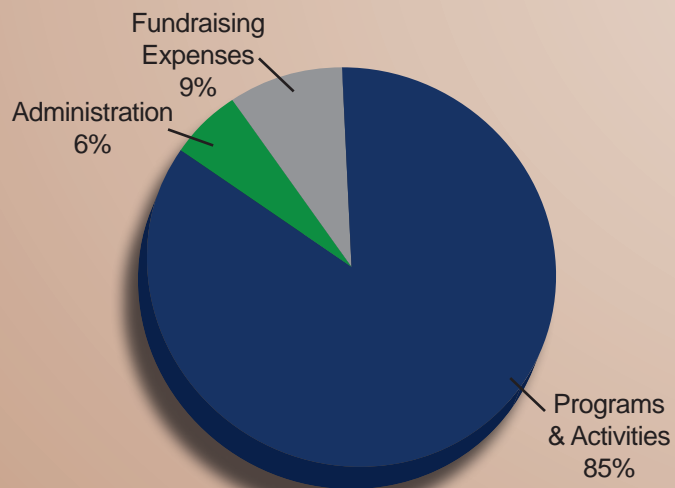


HOW WE ARE FUNDED
